



Licensure Requirements

1. Background:

Obtain your Livescan FBI/DOJ Background check during the EMT course as pre-requisite for. Clinical Observation

 - (a) Find your nearest location by visiting <http://livescan-locations.com/>
 - (b) Refer to our list of offenses and/or criminal implications on your enrollment agreement that may interfere with you obtaining licensure
2. Didactic/Psychomotor
 - (a) Pass your EMT course with a minimum 80% on final written exam and successfully pass all NREMT psychomotor skills testing stations.
3. Course Completion
 - (a) Obtain a course completion certificate from Orange County EMT.
4. National Registry Exam:
 - (a) Apply with the National Registry of EMT's to take your exam
 - (b) Go to nremt.org and create your account
 - (c) Create a new application and pay application fee
 - (d) Choose Orange County CPR as your training program (DBA Orange County EMT)
 - (e) Print the "ATT" letter to schedule your exam through Pearson VUE
 - (f) Take and Pass the NREMT computer-based cognitive exam.
5. County Licensure:
 - (a) Apply to your local county EMS office for licensure.
 - (b) Log onto <http://healthdisasteroc.org/> and follow the specific instructions for submitting all of your documentation. You will find the pertinent information under the Emergency. Medical Services Tab select EMT FAQ
 - (c) Your live scan will have been previously submitted to OCEMS when it was done in class prior to your clinicals: Do not submit it twice
 - (d) Take all of the requested documents, including your Course Completion Certificate to the County EMS Office. They will request proof of completion for OCEMS Policy 315 or the Advanced Accreditation, which is printed on your Course Completion Certificate.
